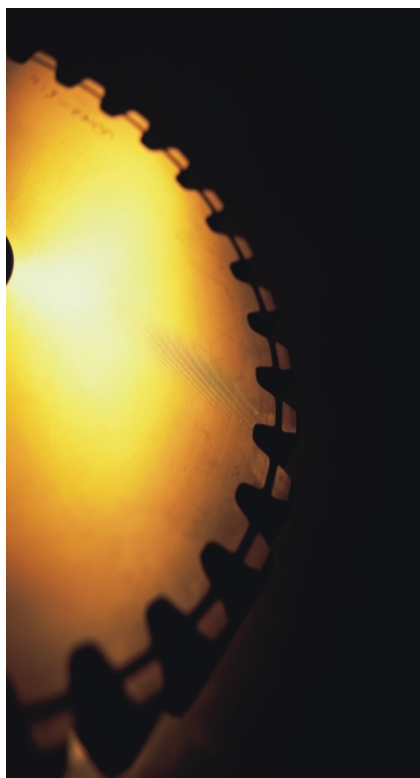

#### MEXICO

This is an update to the 2009 Preferential Tariff Schedule. This update modifies the preferential duty rates for several Free Trade Agreements on products classified in various chapters.

## REGULATORY UPDATES

### AMERICAS

#### ARGENTINA

This is an update to import regulations for Argentina. This update establishes new import certificate requirements and anti-dumping duties on products classified under certain chapters from China. The following HTS chapters are affected: 69 and 73.

#### MEXICO

This is an update to import regulations for Mexico. This update modifies the anti-dumping duties imposed on steel wire mesh from China. The following HTS chapter is affected: 73.

### ASIA-PACIFIC

#### SINGAPORE

1. This is an update to import regulations for Singapore. This update modifies the import requirements for product newly listed in the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES). The following HTS chapters are affected: 03 and 16

2. This is an update to Singapore Import regulations for certain selected food grade products. The type of control affected by this update is: Import License. The following HTS chapters are affected: 28 and 35.

This is an update for addition of import and export embargo against Israel.

**CARRIER SERVICE UPDATES****ASIA-MED**

CMA CGM is pleased to announce improvements to its services from Asia to the Mediterranean. Starting in mid-May, CMA will enter into a Vessel Sharing Agreement with Maersk, which will provide service coverage to western and central Mediterranean from Asia. The port rotation will include the following locations: Lian Yun Gang, Qingdao, Shanghai, Fuzhou, Hong Kong, Chiwan, Yantian, Tanjung Pelepas, Jeddah, Port Said, Gioia Tauro, Genoa, Fos Sur Mer, Damietta, Salalah, Port Kelang, and Singapore. CMA will also update its PHEX/LEVEX service from Asia to the Adriatic. Through a Vessel Sharing Agreement with Maersk, the service will feature faster transit times, with a port rotation that will include the following locations: Shanghai, Busan, Hong Kong, Chiwan, Tanjung Pelepas, Port Kelang, Port Said, Damietta, Trieste, Koper, Rijeka (by feeder), Jeddah, Port Kelang, and Singapore.

**ASIA**

COSCO will extend its Southeast Asia HSH Service to include the ports of Zhanjiang, Shantou, and Singapore. Hong Kong and Ho Chi Minh will also be part of the rotation.

**ASIA-EUR**

Maersk Line is pleased to announce improvements to its Asia-Europe network. Beginning in mid-May, Felixstowe will be added to the port rotation of the westbound AE1 Service, while Le Havre and Southampton will be removed. (There will be no eastbound changes.) Xiamen and Salalah will be added to the westbound loop of the AE6 Service. For the westbound loop of the AE9 Service, the order of the port calls for Bremerhaven and Rotterdam will be switched. Port Said will be removed from the eastbound rotation, and the port of Tangier will replace Algeciras. Le Havre will be added to the westbound loop of the AE10 Service, while Port Said will be removed. CMA will participate in the AE11 Service. The ports of Lian Yun Gang, Chiwan, and Port Kelang will be added to the eastbound loop. Port Said will be added to both the eastbound and westbound loops. The AE12 Service will offer direct coverage between Asia and Adriatic ports.

**US-EUR**

MOL will soon offer direct export service between Jacksonville and key European ports as part of its APX Service. Eastbound port rotation will include the following locations: Miami, Jacksonville, Savannah, Charleston, New York, Rotterdam, Bremerhaven, and Felixstowe.

**US-MED**

Zim is pleased to announce that the ZCS Service between the Mediterranean and North America will resume direct weekly calls at Piraeus. The updated port rotation will include the following locations: Piraeus, Haifa, Livorno, Genoa, Tarragona, Halifax, New York, Savannah, Kingston, Long Beach, Oakland, Shekou, Hong Kong, Yantian, Ningbo, Shanghai, Pusan, Balboa, and Kingston.
